

GROUNDSKEEPER SPECIFICATIONS

Tentative issues for keeping the grounds for the City of Belton Parks and Recreation Department:

Location of Fields

Leda Poore Park, 14367 Hwy. 20, Belton, SC 299627 (beside the Belton Rescue Squad).

M.T. Haynie Park, Guthrie Avenue, Belton, SC 29627.

Terry Martin Field, North Main Street, Belton, SC 29627

Cutting Schedule:

March- twice per month.

April- October- every week

December- twice per month

*Grass should be cut on Monday mornings. Work should be completed by 4:00 p.m.

Duties:

Cut all grass located on properties of city parks as specified by the Director.

Use weed-eater around fences, trees, and shrubs, bleachers, concession stand, dugouts, etc.

Only use round up as specified by the Director.

Use blower on any paved areas after cutting grass.

Rake or vacuum leaves when needed.

Use bagger on the Charles Meeks and David Lance fields (infield and outfield), and at Leda Poore on the grass infield only.

Qualifications:

Must have a business license for the City of Belton, general liability insurance, workman's compensation, and a category 3 commercial pesticide license.

Must have your own equipment.

If you are interested in the groundskeeper bid, please have your sealed bid turned in by April 11, 2014 to Belton City Hall, 306 Anderson St. between 8:30 and 4:30 or mail to PO Box 828, Belton, SC 29627. No bids will be accepted after April 11 at 4:30. All sealed bids will be opened on April 11 at 4:45 at Belton City Hall, 306 Anderson St. Belton.

Please include a list of the equipment which you use, the amount of liability insurance and workman's compensation that you carry, and the number of full time and part time employees who work for you.

***This contract is a one year agreement. It begins July 1, 2014 and goes through June 30, 2015.**
