May 21, 2015 Called Meeting Minutes

I. Call to Order

Mayor Wendell Page called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. All council members were present.

II. Invocation

V. Seamon Whiteside- Leda Poore Plan

Mayor Wendell Page introduced Mr. Chris Watson to Council and visitors. Mr. Watson preceded to show his presentation to the Council with his preliminary plans for Leda Poore. The cost for this plan is approximately \$2,675,000.00. Mayor Wendell Page thanked Mr. Watson with Seamon Whiteside for his work and presentation and stated that Council would meet to discuss it further.

VI. Belton Armory Roof Additional Deck Replacement Fee Charges

Parks and Recreation Director, Joey Lance explained to Council the repairs needed on the short roof both sides and the back end where the concrete decking needs to be replaced. Cost to repair everything is \$32,500.00. We would get a 15 year warranty on the material and 5 year warranty on the labor. Council Member James Bright made a motion to get the repairs done for \$32,500.00 and pay the money out of the Hospitality Fund. Council Member Hattie S. Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
