



For residential customers inside the City of Belton city limits, Garbage pick-up is provided once per week.

- To be collected, all residential garbage shall be placed inside the roll carts. Garbage cannot be placed outside or next to the roll carts. The only bags that will be picked up are those placed inside the roll carts.
- All garbage shall be placed by the curb in front of your residence, unobstructed by fences, poles, vehicles, signs or similar objects.
- If one roll cart is not enough for your weekly household garbage and you need an additional roll cart, please call Belton Combined Utilities Department, 338-0058 extension 152 or 153. For an additional \$2.50 per month, you can request another cart.
- Please place your roll cart at the curb no more than 12 hours prior to the morning of your designated collection day.
- The City will NOT collect roofing shingles, asbestos products, lead paint or other hazardous items that require special disposition.

The schedule is as follows:

Monday – Wards 1 & 2

Tuesday – Wards 3 & 4

Wednesday – 5 & 6



Thursday – recycling all Wards

- Recyclable materials are to be placed in the recycling bin provided by the City.
- All paper to be recycled shall be kept clean and dry, unspoiled by normal household garbage or refuse.

New Roll Carts will be provided to inside residential City of Belton customers
Effective August 15, 2017.

- **How much will the roll cart cost?**
\$2.50 per month will be added to your monthly bill.
- **Who do I call if I need more than one cart?**
Call Belton Combined Utilities Department, extension 152 or 153. For an additional \$2.50 per month, you can request another cart.
- **Will roll carts be required?**
YES, the roll cart is the only approved container, per Ordinance #42-22d (*Garbage is to be contained in an approved container*)
- **Can bags of garbage be placed outside or next to the roll carts?**
NO. The only bags that will be picked up are those placed inside the roll carts.
- **Where does the cart need to be placed for pick-up?**
At the curb in front of your residence, unobstructed by fences, poles, vehicles, signs or similar objects.
- **Who is responsible for the roll cart when I move?**
The user is responsible for the roll cart, per Ordinance 42-25a (*The user or the owner of the property at which the roll-out cart is located (if the user cannot be identified) shall be responsible for the replacement of any damaged, lost or stolen roll-cart. If a cart is damaged, lost or stolen the user, or property owner (in his absence), shall notify the city immediately. It shall be unlawful to move a roll-cart from one residence to another without the consent of the city administrator of his designee.*)
