The Municipal Election Commission of the City of Belton announces the General Election for the City of Belton to be Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

The following offices shall be included in this election:

Councilmember from Ward 2 for term expiring November 2, 2023.

Councilmember from Ward 4 for term expiring November 2, 2023.

Councilmember from Ward 6 for term expiring November 2, 2023.

Mayor for term expiring November 2, 2023.

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by October 6, 2019. To register, one must contact the County Board of Voter Registration.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices may file at Belton City Hall, 306 Anderson Street, Belton SC 29627. Books will be open for filing at 8:00 am on August 9, 2019 and remain open during regular business hours until noon on August 23, 2019.

The filing fee for Council is \$25.00.

The filing fee for Mayor is \$50.00.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The precinct and polling locations are as follows: 011Belton-First Baptist Church, 105 Brown Ave, Belton SC 29627; 111Belton Annex-Belton Community and Recreation Center, 700 Blue Ridge Avenue, Belton, SC 29627.

You will be asked to show one of the following Photo ID's at your polling place:

***S.C. Driver's License *ID card issued by S.C. Dept. of Motor Vehicles**

***S.C. Voter Registration card with photo *Federal Military ID *U.S. Passport**

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on Election Day and close at 7:00 p.m.

At 9:00 AM on said Election Day, the poll managers will begin examining the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Anderson County Board of Elections at 301 N. Main Street, Anderson, SC 29621.

On Thursday, November 7, 2019, at 11:00 AM at the Anderson County Board of Elections at 301 N. Main Street, Anderson, SC 29621, the Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

In the event of a tie, any run-off will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, November 19, 2019.
