GENERAL ELECTION**

The Municipal Election Commission of the City of Belton announces the Special Election for the City of Belton to be **Tuesday, June 22, 2021**.

The office included in this election:

Mayor for term expiring November 2, 2023.

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by **May 23, 2021**. To register, one must contact the County Board of Voter Registration.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices may file at Belton City Hall at 306 Anderson Street, Belton SC 29627. **Books will be open for filing at noon on April 23, 2021 and remain open during regular business hours until noon on May 7, 2021.**

The filing fee for Mayor is \$50.00.

This is a nonpartisan election, and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The precincts involved and polling location are as follows: 011Belton and 111Belton Annex. **Both precincts will be voting at the Belton Community and Recreation Center located at 700 Blue Ridge Avenue, Belton, SC 29627.**

You will be asked to show one of the following Photo ID's at your polling place:

*S.C. Driver's License *ID card issued by S.C. Dept. of Motor Vehicles

*S.C. Voter Registration card with photo *Federal Military ID *U.S. Passport

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. on Election Day and close at 7:00 p.m.

At 9:00 AM on said Election Day, the poll managers will begin examining the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Anderson County Board of Elections at 301 N. Main Street, Anderson, SC 29621.

On Thursday, June 24, 2021, at 09:30 am at the Anderson County Board of Elections at 301 N. Main Street, Anderson, SC 29621, the Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

In the event of a tie, any run-off will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, July 6, 2021.
