

Ordinance Number: 483

**An Ordinance Entitled: TO REPEAL ORDINANCE # 479 AND
AMEND CITY CODE CHAPTER 42, SOLID WASTE: ARTICLE II
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Section 42-19. Definitions.

Garbage means waste generated typically by residential, household operations.

Refuse means yard waste such as tree limbs, leaves, trimmings and other rubbish, including discarded household furnishings and appliances.

SECTION 2. Section 42-22. Collections.

Repeal Ordinance # 479, which was not included in the new code. See (f.) and (g.) below for collection instruction details.

- f.) Refuse (other than garbage) will typically be collected in bulk by the City on a rotating basis when separated by type at the pickup point. Refuse except leaves and grass clippings generated by contractors or others performing services and who benefit directly or indirectly from the activity are responsible for proper disposal. The property owner or tenant shall so inform workers.
- g.) The City will not collect roofing shingles, asbestos products, lead paint or other hazardous items that require special disposition.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Any chapter, article, section or subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its final adoption.
