

Ordinance Number: 494

An Ordinance Entitled: TO AMEND ORDINANCE #491 (BUDGET FY 2008-2009) FOR COUNTY REASSESSMENT

Whereas, Section 12-37-251 (E) of the Code of Laws of South Carolina as amended requires that tax millage be adjusted to reflect changes in assessed values, and

Whereas, Anderson County is implementing reassessment for tax year 2008, and

Whereas, the City of Belton is a municipality within Anderson County, now

Therefore, Section II of Ordinance # 491 is changed to reflect current assessment figures and reads as follows: A total levy of 112 mills* for the City of Belton is hereby adopted. Said tax is and shall be levied on property assessed for taxation for County and State purposes. That a tax to cover the period from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009, both inclusive, for the sums and in the manner hereinafter mentioned, is and shall be levied, collected and paid into the treasury of the City of Belton for the use and service thereof. Said tax shall be in the amount of \$11.20 on every one hundred (\$100.00) dollars in assessed value of real and personal property of every description owned and used in the City of Belton, South Carolina, excepting only that property that is exempt from taxation under the Constitution and laws of the State of South Carolina. Said tax levied and paid into the City Treasury shall be for the use of the City of Belton for its corporate purposes, for permanent improvements and for the purpose of paying current expenses of said municipality.


If for any reason any sentence, clause or provision of the ordinance shall be declared invalid, such shall not affect the remaining provisions thereof.

This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.




