

Ordinance Number: 498

An Ordinance Entitled: Discharging Dangerous Devices

Section I:

- A: It shall be unlawful for any person to point or discharge or cause to be discharged at any person any loaded or unloaded firearm of any kind.
- B: It shall be unlawful within the Corporate Limits for any person to fire or discharge any air gun, pellet gun, sling shot, or mechanical air or gas operated device which throws or projects a bullet, a pellet, BB shots or any form of projectile, which may be used to harm any person or property.
- C: Nothing contained herein, however, shall be construed to abridge the right of self-defense, to apply to theatricals or the like performances or to peace officers in the discharge of their duties.

(1976 S.C. Code 16-23-410)

Section II: If for any reason any sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid, such shall not affect the remaining provisions thereof.

Section III: This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
