ORDINANCE NO. 516

TO PROVIDE FOR AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 504
TO PROVIDE FOR ADJUSTMENT OF MONTHLY
MINIMUM SEWER CHARGE

WHEREAS, the City of Belton, South Carolina (the "City") operates a combined waterworks and sewer system (the "System"); and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained the commitment of United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development ("USDARD") to provide certain loan and grant financing in connection with certain upgrades to be made to the Breazeale, Marshall and Ductworth wastewater treatment plants of the System; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City modify its existing System rate ordinance ("Ordinance No. 504") to cause an increase in the monthly minimum sewer charge for all customers of the System, effective March 1, 2014, in order that the City might fulfill its covenants that the rates and charges for the services and facilities afforded by the System as thus improved shall be sufficient to discharge the obligations of the City to be made in connection with said financing and to satisfy certain of the conditions required by USDARD in connection therewith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELTON IN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1.

The facts set forth in the recitals of this Ordinance have been carefully investigated and are found to be in all respects correct.

SECTION 2.

Ordinance No. 504 is hereby amended, effective as of March 1, 2014, to provide for a monthly minimum sewer charge for the first 2,000 gallons of use of \$26.90 for inside City customers, and \$53.80 for outside City customers. Except as so amended, all other provisions of Ordinance No. 504 shall remain in full force and effect.

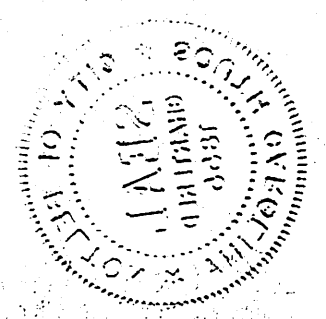
