

Ordinance Number: 518

Amended Ordinance for Fixing the Date of Election of Mayor and Members of Council in Wards 2,4,6 for the Term Beginning Upon Taking Office in May 2014 and to the Last Day of February 2018.

Whereas, Section 5-15-10 et.seq. Of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, (1976), as amended, set forth the provisions relative to the adoption of an ordinance governing election procedures in nonpartisan municipal elections; and

Whereas, it now appears that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Belton, South Carolina to enact an Ordinance governing the new date for the nonpartisan elections for the offices of Mayor and Council Members and to adopt a procedure in accordance with South Carolina Law; and

Therefore, Be It Ordained by the City Council for the City of Belton, South Carolina that:

Section I. The Council Member for Ward 2, Ward 4, Ward 6 and Mayor shall be elected for a period of three years and ten months and shall serve as such beginning upon taking office in May 2014 through the last day of February, 2018.

Section II. The aforementioned nonpartisan election shall be held on April 22, 2014. Polls shall open at 7:00 am and close at 7:00 pm. Voting will take place at Precinct Number 1 (1st Baptist Church, 105 Brown Ave. Belton, SC)

Section III. The nonpartisan election and run-off election method as prescribed in Section 5-15-62 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended, shall be utilized to determine the results of the nonpartisan elections.

Section IV. This Ordinance ratified this 1 day of April, 2014.
