

**Ordinance Number: 521**

**An Ordinance Entitled: Amendment to the Belton City Code Article III Livestock:  
Section 6-80 Defined; prohibited; at large; seizure authorized (b), (c) and (d)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELTON,  
SOUTH CAROLINA

Article III Section 6-80 of the Belton City Code is hereby amended by changing the wording in (b) to read as follows: The term poultry shall mean chicken or like birds, raised for use or pleasure and kept for use or profit. (c) No livestock, including swine, goats, and chicken or like birds shall be kept within the corporate limits. (d) It shall be the duty of the chief of police and city policemen to seize all such animals found running at large, and to impound them in some convenient place. (Code 2001. § 3.301)

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON ITS FINAL ADOPTION.

ARTICLE III. LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

---

**Sec. 6-80. Defined; prohibited; at large; seizure authorized.**

- (a) The term "livestock" shall mean animals kept or raised for use or pleasure, especially farm animals kept for use and profit.
- (b) The term poultry shall mean chicken or like birds, raised for use or pleasure and kept for use or profit.
- (c) No livestock, including swine, goats and chicken or like birds shall be kept within the corporate limits.
- (d) It shall be the duty of the chief of police and city policemen to seize all such animals found running at large, and to impound them in some convenient place. *(Code 2001, § 3.301)*
