

ORDINANCE NO. 530

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
THE FEBRUARY 7, 2017, SPECIAL
ELECTION FOR THE MUNICIPAL
COUNCIL SEAT FOR SEAT WARD 3**

WHEREAS, the SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS, 1976, Section 7-13-190 provides that a special election to fill a vacancy in office to be held the thirteenth Tuesday after the vacancy occurs, and

WHEREAS, Jay West, Councilman for Seat Ward 3 will vacate his office effective November 13, 2016; and


WHEREAS, candidates for said election shall be elected to serve the unexpired term of Jay West which ends the first (1st) Tuesday in November.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELTON, SOUTH CAROLINA, THAT:

- A) The special election for the Municipal Council Seat Ward 3 shall be held according to the following schedule:
 - 1. Special ElectionTuesday, February 7, 2017
 - 2. Filing Period for CandidatesFriday, December 2, 2016 Noon through Monday, December 12, 2016 Noon
 - 3. Run-off Election, If NecessaryTuesday, February 21, 2017
- B) The filing for candidacy shall be initiated at the City of Belton City Hall. Upon completion of the Statement of Intention of Candidacy form, payment of the \$25.00 filing fee shall be submitted to the City Clerk and Treasurer at City Hall, 306 Anderson Street Belton, SC 29627.
- C) All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict. All State laws and City ordinances not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect, and shall be applicable to all future elections.
- D) This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and Council of the City of Belton.




