Meeting Minutes

July 6, 2021

1. Call to Order

Mayor Eleanor Dorn called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. All Council Members were present.

2. Invocation

Council Member Lynda McCoy opened the meeting with prayer.

3. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Eleanor Dorn led the Pledge of Allegiance with everyone participating.

4. Welcome Visitors and Guests

Mayor Eleanor Dorn welcomed all visitors and guests.

5. Approval of Council Minutes – June 1, 2021

No Minutes were approved at this meeting due to Helen Willis being out sick.

6. Gazebo Presentation

Elizabeth Fant discussed giving the city a new gazebo to place at the head of the Bubblegum Trail.

7. Belton Square Beautification Update

The Belton Beautification Committee gave an update on the needs for the upcoming year for the Square.

8. Mayor Pro-Tempore Appointment

Mayor Eleanor Dorn opened the floor for nominations for Mayor Pro-Tempore.

Council Member Tony Saville nominated James Bright for the position of Mayor Pro-Tempore. James Bright stated he would accept if elected.

Ricky Campbell nominated Josh Stephenson for the position of Mayor Pro-Tempore. Lynda McCoy made a second motion. Josh Stephenson state he would accept the position if he was elected.

There were no further nominations.

Mayor Eleanor Dorn made a motion to vote James Bright for the position of Mayor Pro-Tempore. Two votes were cast: Council Member James Bright and Council Member Tony Saville.

Mayor Eleanor Dorn made a motion to vote Josh Stephenson for the position of Mayor Pro-Tempore. Three votes were cast for Josh Stephenson: Council Members Lynda McCoy, Ricky Campbell and Josh Stephenson.

Council Member Josh Stephenson was elected to the position of Mayor Pro-Tempore. Mayor Eleanor Dorn abstained from voting due to it being an even number that would be voting.

9. Belton Museum Request

Abigail Burden discussed the possibility of moving forward with the Natural Museum of History in the future. She stated the need of the land that the City owns across the street. No action was taken at this time.

10. Other Business

Mayor Eleanor Dorn brought up for discussion to have Smart Marketing create brochures and a logo to promote the City of Belton. This will also allow us to distribute these to citizens with important information on them. Council Member Josh Stephenson made a motion to design and purchase these brochures for the cost of \$4,308.23. Council Member Ricky Campbell seconded the motion.

Discussion: Alan Sims stated this money would come from Hospitality funds since it was promoting the City of Belton. Motion carried unanimously.


11. Adjournment
