1. Call to Order

Mayor Eleanor Dorn called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. All Council Members were present.

Council Member James Bright made a motion to approve \$1000.00 to be used for advertising at BHP ball games. Council Member Tony Saville second the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

8. Adjournment


Council Member Ricky Campbell made a motion with no further business to adjourn. Motion seconded by Council Member Tony Saville. All in favor to adjourn.
