

ORDINANCE 560

AN ORDINANCE TO RAISE REVENUE AND ADOPT A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BELTON, SOUTH CAROLINA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2023

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF BELTON, SOUTH CAROLINA THAT:

WHEREAS, Section 5-7-260(3) of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, (1976) as amended, requires that municipal councils shall act by ordinance to adopt budgets and levy taxes pursuant to public notice; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Belton duly assembled desire to adopt a budget for the fiscal year to begin on July 1, 2022, and end on June 30, 2023, and establish a tax millage for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, that the Mayor and City Council have accepted and adopted the following for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, budget for expenditure and estimated revenue.

Section 1. Budget Adoption. The City Council hereby adopts the budget for the City of Belton for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023.

Section 2. A copy of said budget shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof as if set out fully herein, upon final adoption. A copy of said budget shall be filed in the office of the City Administrator at City Hall, for public inspection during regular office hours.

Section 3. The budget totals adopted herein are as follows:

General Fund	\$3,778,805
Water Fund	\$1,177,220
Sewer Fund	\$1,141,820
Hospitality Fund	\$ 674,445

Section 4. Millage - A total levy of 125 mills* for the City of Belton is hereby adopted. Said tax is and shall be levied on property assessed for taxation for County and State purposes. That a tax to cover the period from July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, both inclusive, for the sums and in the manner hereinafter mentioned, is and shall be levied, collected and paid into the treasury of the City of Belton for the use and service thereof. Said tax shall be in the amount of \$125 dollars on every one thousand (\$1,000) dollars in assessed value of real and personal property of every description owned and used in the City of Belton, South Carolina, excepting only that property that is exempt from taxation under the Constitution and laws of the State of South Carolina. Said tax levied and paid into the City Treasury shall be for the use of the City of Belton for its corporate purposes, for permanent improvements and for the purpose of paying current expenses of said municipality.

Section 5. Fees. The Comprehensive Fee Schedule for the City of Belton is hereby approved and made a part of this Ordinance as fully as if incorporated herein to be effective July 1, 2022.

Section 6. The Administrative Department of the City of Belton shall be responsible for the collection of taxes through the agreement with Anderson County.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2022.






