## **Meeting Minutes**

### **September 6, 2022**

1. **Call to Order**

Mayor Eleanor Dorn called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. All councilmembers were present.

2. **Invocation**

Councilmember Ricky Campbell made a motion to approve ordinance #561 Second and Final reading. Councilmember Josh Stephenson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

7. **Second and Final Reading Ordinance #562 – ANNEXATION & REZONING OF SPECIFIC PROPERTY – BLAKE DAIRY ROAD AND LOT 2 LONGSHORE DRIVE**

Read in its entirety by City Administrator Alan Sims. Mayor Eleanor Dorn asked for a motion to approve ordinance #562 - Annexation of Blake Dairy Rd. (RM1) Property. Councilmember Brandy Vaughn made a motion to approve ordinance #562 Second and Final reading. Councilmember Tony Saville seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**8. First and Final Reading of Resolution 2022-004 – RESOLUTION COMMITTING THE CITY OF BELTON TO PROVIDING A LOCAL MATCH FOR A MUNICIPAL ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA HOMETOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT AND FOLLOWING ITS PROCUREMENT POLICY WHEN SECURITY SERVICES AND PRODUCTS WITH GRANT FUNDS**

Administrator Alan Sims discussed a \$25,000.00 Grant from the MASC to install a Dog Park behind the Library. Mayor Eleanor Dorn asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2022-004 Economic Development Grant for a Dog Park. Councilmember Mark Spence made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-004. 
Fire Chief Brad Maness informed Mayor and Council about a FEMA Grant for \$62,000 to replace Fire Department Air Compressor.
