Meeting Minutes

December 6, 2022

1. **Call to Order**

Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. All Council Members were present except Mayor Eleanor Dorn and Council Member Mark Spence.

2. **Invocation**

Council Member Brandy Vaughn opened the meeting with prayer.

3. **Pledge of Allegiance**

Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson led the Pledge of Allegiance with everyone participating.

4. **Welcome Visitors and Guests**

Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson welcomed all visitors and guests.

5. **Approval of Minutes – September 6, 2022 (revised) October 4, 2022, and November 1, 2022**

Mayor Pro Tem asked for a motion to approve the minutes from September 6, 2022, as revised, October 4, 2022, and November 1, 2022, regular meetings as read. Council Member Ricky Campbell made a motion to approve the minutes as read, seconded by Council Member Tony Saville. Motion carried unanimously.

6. **Resolution #2022-005 Adoption of City of Belton Cafeteria Plan**

Read by Title only by City Administrator Alan Sims. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson asked for a motion to approve Resolution #2022-005 Adoption of City of Belton Cafeteria Plan (Flexible Benefits Plan effective January 1, 2023, thru December 31, 2023). Council Member Tony Saville made a motion to approve Resolution #2022-005, seconded by Council Member Ricky Campbell. Motion carried unanimously.

7. **Building Donation from Belton Emergency Services**

City Administrator Alan Sims informed the Mayor and Council the Belton Emergency Services is donating the building located at 14515 Highway 20 and the adjacent vacant lot to the City of Belton with no stipulations. The building will be used for various purposes. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson asked for a motion to accept the donation from the Belton Emergency Services to the City of Belton. Council Member Ricky Campbell made a motion to accept the donation from the Belton Emergency Services, seconded by Council Member Tony Saville. Motion carried unanimously.

8. **Resolution #2022-006 Adoption for Premium Pay Under American Rescue Plan Act**

Resolution #2022-007 Authorizing and Approving the Acceptance of Certain Loan Assistance Monies from the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority; Authorizing the Mayor to Execute that Certain Loan Assistance Agreement Between the City of Belton and the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority; and Other Matters Relating Thereto.

Read by Title only by City Administrator Alan Sims. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson asked for a motion to approve Resolution #2022-007 Authorizing and Approving the Acceptance of Certain Loan Assistance Monies from the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority; Authorizing the Mayor to Execute that Certain Loan Assistance Agreement Between the City of Belton and the South Carolina Water Quality Revolving Fund Authority; and Other Matters Relating Thereto. Council Member Brandy Vaughn made a motion to approve Resolution #2022-007, seconded by Council Member Joshua Hawkins. Motion carried unanimously.

10. Ordinance #563 Amending the Business License Ordinance, First Reading

Read by Title only by City Administrator Alan Sims. Treasurer Amanda Gambrell presented to Mayor and Council Ordinance #563, Amending Business License to correct fees. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson asked for a motion to approve Ordinance #563 Amending the Business License Ordinance. Council Member Tony Saville made a motion to approve Ordinance #563 Amending the Business License, seconded by Council Member Ricky Campbell. Motion carried unanimously.

11. Ordinance #564 Rezoning of Calhoun Road Property, First Reading

Read by Title only by City Administrator Alan Sims. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson asked for a motion to approve Ordinance #564 Rezoning of Calhoun Road Property. Council Member Tony Saville made a motion to approve Ordinance #564, Rezoning of Calhoun Road Property, to construct new homes, seconded by Council Member Brandy Vaughn. Motion carried unanimously.


12. Other Business/Announcements


