## **Meeting Minutes**

### **March 7, 2023**

1. **Call to Order**

Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. All Council Members were present except Mayor Eleanor Dorn and Council Member Ricky Campbell.

2. **Invocation**

3. **Pledge of Allegiance**

4. **Welcome Visitors and Guests**

5. **Approval of Minutes – February 13, 2023**

Read by Title only by City Administrator Alan Sims. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson made a motion to approve Ordinance #566 Intergovernmental Agreement to SC Local Revenue Services. Council Member Mark Spence made a motion to approve Ordinance #566, seconded by Council Member Joshua Hawkins. Motion carried unanimously.

7. **Ordinance #567 – Amending Section 18-5 of the Belton City Code to Limit the Age of Mobile Homes Within the City Limits of Belton, South Carolina**

Read by Title only by City Administrator Alan Sims. Mayor Pro Tem Josh Stephenson asked for a motion to approve Ordinance #567 Amending Section 18-5 of the Belton City Code to Limit the Age of Mobile Homes in the City Limits. Council Member Tony Saville made a motion to approve Ordinance #567, seconded by Council Member Mark Spence. Motion carried unanimously.


**8. Other Business**
