AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BELTON CITY CODE
ARTICLE III SECTION 6-80 (b), (c), and (d)
.....

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2014, the City Council (the "Council") of City of Belton, South Carolina (the "Municipality"), adopted an ordinance to amend the Belton City Code Article III Livestock; Section 6-80 changing to wording in item (b), (c), and (d);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL IN A MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED, AS FOLLOWS:

Article III Section 6-80 of the Belton City Code is hereby amended by changing the wording in (b) to read as follows: The term poultry shall mean chicken, or like birds, peacock, pea fowl, guineas, or other fowl raised for use or pleasure and kept for use or profit. (c) No livestock, including swine, goats, and chickens or like birds, peacock, pea fowl, guineas, or other fowl shall be kept within the city limits. (d) It shall be the duty of the chief of police and city policemen to seize all such animals found running at large, and to impound them in some convenient place.

The following shall be excepted from the provisions of this section:

1. Zoos, fairs, shows and like exhibits issued permits by the city for the showing and keeping of such fowl.
2. Parrots, parakeets, cockatoos, cockatiels, lovebirds and similar indoor pet birds actually kept in a residence in confinement, if in compliance with state and federal law.
3. Waterfowl on any public lake or pond or other lake or pond used by the public such as a subdivision lake or pond.


